Introduction

Thank you for purchasing the SCOUTmicro KVM Switch. This product will ensure easy and accurate control over 2 PCs from a single console. The SCOUTmicro KVM Switch is compatible with PS/2 or USB style computers. It has keyboard and mouse emulation for error free boot-ups and supports a wide variety of mice including the Microsoft Intellimouse. The SCOUTmicro supports high resolutions of up to 2048 x 1536 without any deterioration of the image quality. Switching between PCs can be accomplished through keyboard Hot Key commands.

Product Features

- Allows a user to control two computers from one console.
- Works with Windows 95/98/2000/ME/NT/XP and Linux.
- No drivers or additional software are required for operation.
- No external power supply required.
- Keyboard and mouse emulation allows for error free boot-up.
- The [CAPS LOCK], [SCROLL LOCK] and [NUM LOCK] status is stored for each computer.
- Supports Monitor resolutions of up to 2048 x 1536 @ 85Hz.
- Supports VGA, SVGA and MultiSync monitors.
- Keyboard Hot Key control.
- Comes with Auto-Scan mode for convenient automatic switching.
- LEDs give a clear indication of the active PC.

Installation

Before connecting your computers and console devices to the SCOUTmicro switch, please ensure that all devices are powered off. Connecting devices while powered on may lead to damage to your computers or the SCOUTmicro. Daxten cannot be held responsible for damage caused by connecting devices that are powered.

1. Place the SCOUTmicro switch in a convenient location; its small size makes it easy to place it on the desktop.
2. Connecting the console devices SCOUTmicro PS/2 and SCOUTmicro USB:
 - 2.1. Connect your monitor's HD 15-pin connector to the SCOUTmicro's Monitor 'CONSOLE' device on the front panel.
 - 2.2. Connect your PS/2 keyboard to the PS/2 keyboard connector (purple) and your PS/2 mouse to the PS/2 mouse connector (green) on the front panel of the SCOUTmicro.
3. Connecting the computers with PS/2 ports via the integrated cable:
 - 3.1. Connect the blue HD 15-pin male connector to the VGA port on your computer.
 - 3.2. Connect the purple PS/2 (6-pin MiniDIN) keyboard connector to the PS/2 keyboard port on your computer.
 - 3.3. Connect the green PS/2 (6-pin MiniDIN) mouse connector to the PS/2 mouse port on your computer.
4. Connecting the computers with USB ports via the integrated cable:
 - 4.1. Connect the blue HD 15-pin male connector to the VGA port on your computer.
 - 4.2. Connect the USB connector to a USB port on your computer.
5. Power up the computers. The computer connected to the first port will be shown on the monitor. You may check if the keyboard and mouse work after the system has booted up. If you find that the keyboard or mouse is not working correctly please verify that all cables are properly connected.

Using the SCOUTmicro KVM Switch

To switch from one PC to another with the SCOUTmicro KVM Switch you have to use the keyboard Hot Key commands. You may notice that the mouse cannot be used for around 2 seconds when the SCOUTmicro switches to another computer. This is normal and is caused by the synchronization process which ensures that the mouse operates correctly.

Keyboard Hot Key commands

To send Hot Key commands to the SCOUTmicro kvm switch, press and release **Ctrl** **Ctrl** within 2 seconds. Press a command key for the desired effect. The following commands are supported:

First Key	Second Key	Command Key	Command Result
Ctrl	Ctrl	1 or 2	Switches to the desired PC
Ctrl	Ctrl	↑	Switch to previous PC
Ctrl	Ctrl	↓	Switch to next PC
Ctrl	Ctrl	S	Auto-Scan mode ON
Ctrl	Ctrl	0	Auto-Scan mode OFF
Ctrl	Ctrl	S 0	Scan 8 Seconds (default)
Ctrl	Ctrl	S 1	Scan 15 Seconds
Ctrl	Ctrl	S 2	Scan 30 Seconds
Ctrl	Ctrl	S 3	Scan 60 Seconds

In Auto-Scan mode, the image shown on the monitor will automatically switch to the next computer. The delay is user definable (see Table above). After the last computer has been shown, the first computer will be shown again.

Note: In this mode there is no mouse or keyboard control.

Press any key to exit the Auto-Scan mode. The SCOUTmicro switch will stop at the last PC shown.

The Hot Key sequence can be changed if required.

To change from the factory default of **Ctrl** **Ctrl**, please use the following sequence:

[OLD HOT KEY] [NEW HOT KEY]

for example: **Ctrl** **Ctrl** **Scroll Lock** **Scroll Lock**
New Hot Key: Scroll Lock Scroll Lock

The following combinations are available for Hot Keys:

Ctrl **Ctrl** (default) **Alt** **Alt** **Scroll Lock** **Scroll Lock** **Shift** **Shift**

Technical Support

If you cannot determine the nature of a problem, please call Daxten and ask for Technical Support.
